Level 3:

- Can you respond to geographical questions?
- Can you use geographical skills and sources of evidence?



Level 4:

- Can you suggest some geographical questions to investigate?
- Can you use a range of geographical skills and evidence to answer the questions?
- Can you use geographical words in your writing?

Level 5:

- Do you know which geographical questions you are going to answer?
- Have you selected the different skills and evidence to use?
- Have you reached any conclusions?
- Have you presented your findings in writings and graphs where you can?

Level 6:

- Have you chosen your questions and the steps you are going to take to answer them?
- Have you chosen the different evidence you will use and the skills you will make use of?
- Have you presented sensible conclusions?

Level 7:

- Have you worked on your own where possible to choose questions to answer and the steps you are going to take to answer them?
- Have you chosen the different evidence to collect and the skills to use?
- Have you evaluated these?
- Have you reached conclusions and backed these up with evidence?

Level 8:

- Have you worked on your own to choose questions and steps to take to answer these?
- Have you used different skills & evidence in answering?
- Have you evaluated what you have been doing?
- Have you reached conclusions that are backed up with your evidence?
